June and August 2023 - booking must be 2 weeks ahead

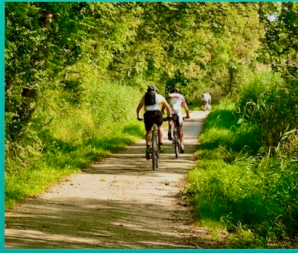
Be one of the first touring with us from Amsterdam, Volendam, Arnhem to farmers area Twente. Every week in August
